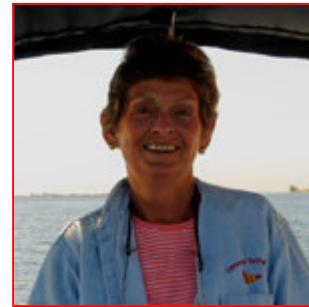

Directions to the club by land can be found on the CSC website under "Cruise Schedule". If you need to call us that day after 11 AM call Frank's cell phone at 410-925-0975. There are a few slips available at the club but I need to know in advance if you want a slip so I can inform the Fleet Captain at Belvedere. You can also anchor in front of the marina. We will have a book exchange table and a business meeting will follow dinner to elect a new Commodore and Treasurer.



The menu for the picnic will be pork barbecue, fried chicken, slaw, wine, soda, beer, and ice tea plus whatever side or dessert you want to bring. Please bring enough food to serve

8 people and your serving utensil. In order to have a balanced menu email or call to let me know what dish you will bring.

We have a picnic planned at Sailing Emporium in Rock Hall on Saturday, September 19. The menu will be crab cakes or grilled chicken breast (if you don't want crab cakes), corn on the cob, tomatoes, beer, wine, and water. Lois Nance will order the crab cakes and I will buy the chicken breasts so we need to know your choice when you give me your reservation. We are asking each person to bring either an appetizer or dessert so tell me know what you want to bring. If you want to reserve a slip for the weekend call the marina at 410-778-1342.
